Overton Community Council Planning Committee requests clarification on the following queries/questions with regards to the above application

Please note: - The comments made by Mr and Mrs Hughes regarding application 0570 were taken into consideration by Overton Council Planning Committee.

- 1. The height of the proposed building appears to be extremely high when the purpose of the building is housing of cattle. The proposed height would have a visual impact on the local residents.
- 2. The siting of the building, as shown on the plan, would mean that there would be an increase in noise, traffic movement and possibly a smell from manure to the all the properties in the vicinity.
- 3. Further clarification is required with regards to the storage, removal and disposal of the effluent. The plan does not show the buildings interior infrastructure e.g. no internal gulleys or stalls etc.
- 4. Could an explanation be given as to what the building will be used for during the remaining six months of the year when the cattle are not being housed?
- 5. No Environmental or Conservation inspection has been carried out on the land. It is known that Great Crested Newts are located in the immediate area. Overton Community Council formally requests that the necessary inspections are carried out as soon as possible.
- 6. How many cattle will be housed at any one stage in this building?
