Overton Community Council Planning Committee strongly objects to the timber framed car port (retrospective).

In point 3.4 it states 'The roofing material is suitably 'agricultural' in terms of colour, corrugation and blends in well with the timber frame' Overton Community Council wishes to point out that Overton is not an 'agricultural' area, but a Conservation village and as such the car port is not in keeping with its surroundings.

In point 3.6 it states 'the area's character is unaffected by the proposal as a car port cannot be seen from the main road'. The car port's design and corrugated roof does affect the character of the area, is unfitting and can be seen from the A539.

The committee noted that they had received objections from members of the community regarding this proposal.
