On behalf of the Overton Growers may I submit a request to the OCC to award a grant towards the £150 outlay for the plants as detailed below.

The planters at the library are now planted and the hanging baskets ordered: the village hall tubs are scheduled for this weekend by Knolton Nurseries: Eastwick Plant Centre will complete the replanting at the war memorial and the Twinning will plant the twinning monument and we, the Growers will tidy and refurbish the Calor monument. We also commit to any remedial planting throughout the year in order to keep up the high standard that the village deserves.

Unfortunately this year our costs to provide these plants will eventually total around £150 as it has not been possible to obtain as much discount and donated plants as plant supply to the shops and nurseries has been severely disrupted due to many orders cancelled by suppliers due to Covid-19, leaving the end retailer short on stock with the obvious consequences.

I am pleased to confirm that, as per last year, the Overton Growers will continue to water and tidy as necessary the village library planters and hanging baskets, the village hall tubs and front wall and the high street the war memorial, twinning and calor monuments.
