5. **2021.05 INTERNAL INSPECTION OF THE FOOTBALL PAVILION**

The Playingfield Committee inspected the recent damage to the pipes in the football pavilion caused by a recent cold spell (several days heavy frost)

- The leaks have been fixed, but there was damage to the ceilings and repairs are needed
- The cold-water tanks and pipes needed to be lagged
- A meeting has been arranged with the chair of the football club and OCC on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2023
