- A new climbing wall and a set of swings for older children was installed in September 2022
- The new Trim Trail was installed in June 2022 (A consultation exercise was held in October 2021 and invitations for a set of 4 new pieces of exercise equipment were sent out).

6. 2023.06 INTERNAL INSPECTION OF THE FOOTBALL PAVILION

- The pavilion is in good condition and the outside is in good order.
- The cold-water tanks and pipes in the loft require lagging before winter.
- The Home Team toilet cistern requires attention.
- With regard to the review of shower provision, it was decided that due to the very limited usage of the facilities, no further action or expense is warranted.

7. 2023.07 MILENNIUM MEADOW

- The fence behind the football pitch requires attention. Cllr Lynch to source posts and rails (Councillors will effect repairs, date TBC)
- Trim Trail The base post cover on the Ski pole equipment needs securing.

8. <u>2023.08 PLAYPARK</u>

- The surrounds encompassing the fort and other areas now need immediate action Cllr Lynch will approach Paul at Eastwick for this and other repairs in the playground.
- The zip wire hose needs attention Cllr Lynch will make temporary repairs, Clerk to contact the original supplier.
- The nesting swing requires new D-rings Cllr Lynch to action
- The yellow play train roof requires slates to be replaced Eastwick
- Various tree branches are overhanging play equipment. This will be addressed by the a Community Council working Party

9. 2023.09 MAIN CAR PARK TOILETS

- Cleanliness was slightly less than the normal high standard expected at 10:00 in the morning
- Toilet block requires a thorough weeding around the edges. The hedge outside the male toilet door needs to be cut and the Ivy needs to be cut back and brambles removed – Clerk to discuss with the Ground Maintenance Contractor
