- 6. 2024.18 To discuss the Earmarked reserves for 2024-2025
 - The Committee decided that the General Reserve, currently £15776.72 should remain separate from all earmarked allocated funds.
 - Overton Events fund

Remaining fund after this year's Fete is £2853.72. Cllr Copeman suggested a smaller fete allocation could be agreed, lower than the current allocation in the precept.

- Strategic Planning fund
 - Current fund of £6732.39. The Committee agreed to use this for future projects.
- Overton Community fund (Jubilee) £3521.20

- 7. 2024.19 To discuss the provision of grants, funds and donations
 - Community Chest
 - Current fund £3963.95 is likely to be spent after 2024 applications are addressed.
 - Annual grants Playcentre, Twinning, Oracle, RBL all need to be approved for 2025-2026
 VE day and VJ day will be organised by the Royal British Legion who may wish to apply for financial support from OCC.
- 8. 2024.20 To discuss the proposed new Precept for the new financial year 2025-2026 aligned with the budget in the summary report
 - The Scribe Budget summary for 2024-2025 now mirrors the exact allocated budget in the Precept/Budget calculations as decided by OCC in November 2023 ready for 2024-2025 (and recorded on the OCC precept spreadsheet).
 - The Income budget is not included in the allocated budget as it is unpredictable.
 - The reserve budget is not included as part of the allocated budget.

 Note: there is an element of precept allocation considered under the "Grants" line in the precept, to address fete costs.

Financial risks

- Environmental, building materials and maintenance costs
 - Football pavilion and toilet
 - Car park toilet
 - Play equipment, especially of wooden construction
 - Tree maintenance
- Payroll increase in wages should be accounted for in the budget/precept
- Other risks are easier to predict, but none are 100% predictable
- There is a risk that some services currently funded by the local authority will disappear and those costs will have to be considered by OCC e.g. current library service in Overton
